As an early childhood educator and being fully qualified I have an in depth understanding of the new EYLF (Early Years Learning Framework) and national quality framework.

I will be practicing the new EYLF in my service every day and will be reaching all 5 outcomes when setting up experiences with your child:

Outcome 1: Children have a strong sense of identity.

Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world.

Outcome 3: Children have a strong sense of wellbeing.

Outcome 4: Children are confident and involved learners.

Outcome 5: Children are effective communicators.

I do believe children learn through play and hands on experiences.

Children need guidance from peers and have a carer who will extend on their interests.

I am a very talkative person and constantly speak to children. I always ask questions with open ended answers to encourage communication (Outcome 5).

Children should take part in activities that interest them. These need to be meaningful, fun and in a secure environment.

All children are unique and all have different needs. I will cater for each child in my care regardless of their lifestyle, gender, religion and culture.

I will set up activities that promote cognitive, social, fundamental and physical skills that will develop positive self esteem and confidence.

I believe children need FREEDOM to learn! Children need encouragement from peers to achieve the next stage of their development. So as a child care worker I will acknowledge children's efforts and help them reach the next stage of their development.

I know families are a very important part of children's lives and I know how stressful it can be leaving your little ones so I welcome all families to communicate with me at all times on a comfortable level.

I will make sure all children in my care have all their needs met, and feel safe in a non- violent environment. I will give every child in my care the love and respect they deserve. Every child in my care is EQUAL and WILL be treated the SAME.
